The PBIS model is rooted in safety for all students and staff, as well as academic and social success for every student. These values align with Fox Hollow's rigorous expectations for high achievement and positive character development.

One of the first steps in becoming a PBIS school is to create a foundation of consistency in regards to what behaviors we value at Fox Hollow. These positively stated expectations are the backbone in establishing consistency amongst staff in how we recognize appropriate behaviors in students. The expectations have been laid out in a fun format; perhaps your child(ren) has come home talking about Franz the Fox, mascot for our local Major League Soccer team, the Colorado Rapids. Franz visited Fox Hollow over the summer and he helped us make videos

to show the students their expected behavior in the hallways, playground, bathrooms, cafeteria, and assemblies. The students have loved the videos, and our staff is excited about aligning our expectations and continuing to strive for our Mission of *Every Child a Lifelong Learner*.

PBIS schools focus on creating a safe environment. That is why Fox Hollow is continuing to implement the curriculum Bully-Proofing Your School (BPYS). BPYS is not new to the district, and in fact the curriculum was created by Cherry Creek staff and has been used for several years. The Cherry Creek School District Board of Education has recently adopted the fourth edition of this curriculum as a universal strategy for addressing issues of conflict and bullying in our schools.

# Instructions for Online Parent Forms

- 1. Sign in to website cherrycreekschools.org
- 2. At the bottom, far right side of the page, click on "Parent Forms"
- 3. Click on "New to Parent Forms?" to register your child(ren). YOU make up your own user name and password...something that will be easy for you to remember.
- 4. You will be taken to CCSD's Parent Portal Registration. Click on "Register in the Parent Portal" to create an account. Fill in the required information. You will need your student's ID number, which can be found on their last report card. You may also come by the front office, show your driver's license, and get your child's ID number.
- 5. You will receive an email within minutes from Parent Registration at Cherry Creek School District. Go to that email and click on the link to activate your account. This email is time sensitive and you will have only 3 hours to activate your account.
- 6. After you do all of that, you're ready to go and enter all of your child's information.
- 7. If you have any questions or problems, you can stop by the front office or call us at 720-886-8700.



Our school is offering a new club for 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade students beginning this year. The *Battle of the Books Club* is designed to encourage elementary students to:

- **Read** quality literature.
- Read over the summer months and in their leisure time during the school year.
- **Read** for information as well as pleasure.

By choosing to participate in this club, your child will be introduced to a variety of fiction and nonfiction books. Fourth and fifth graders are given the opportunity to participate in the Battle of the Books Club. Students of all reading levels are invited to participate. Students read at least seven titles from a book list. Many of the books are award-winning pieces of literature.

During the 2012/2013 school year, students will participate in 10 book club sessions. The meetings are held on Friday mornings from 7:45 – 8:45. During the book club meetings, participating students will work collaboratively to discuss the books and respond to questions about plot, characters, setting and theme. Regular attendance at the Battle of the Books Club meetings is expected.

In January 2013, a school battle will take place at Fox Hollow Elementary. Students work in teams of five to compete against one another.
